

Public Assistance for the COVID-19 Pandemic

Management Costs

FEMA understands that there will be costs associated with managing the Public Assistance (PA) Program and Grant process, and so has created a project specifically to capture these costs.

Category Z Management Costs projects are obligated/awarded at an estimated 5% of the Federal share of all the applicant's other projects for the disaster. Final award amount of the Cat Z Project is based on actual, documented management costs up to 5% of the total project award amount. Management costs will be funded at 100 percent Federal share.

Please note that this is a 5% cap, and that **even eligible management costs incurred above that 5% cap are ineligible** for reimbursement.

Management costs will be funded at 100 percent Federal share.

Dates & Deadlines

- The COVID-19 Incident Period closes on May 11, 2023.
- All eligible applicants may claim management costs incurred through May 11, 2025 (two years from the close of the COVID-19 Incident Period)
- The deadline for submitting a management costs project application is currently to be determined.

Examples of Eligible Items

- Meetings about the PA Program or overall PA damage/cost claim
- Travel expenses and/or training
- Purchased equipment/materials necessary to manage the grant (subject to disposition requirements)
- Time spent preparing eligible Small and Large Project Worksheets and/or Streamlined Apps
- Collecting, copying, filing, or submitting documents to support an eligible Project Worksheet
- Requesting disbursement of PA funds for eligible Project Worksheets

Please Note: Time/costs spent working on projects that are determined ineligible are also ineligible for Cat Z Management Cost reimbursement.
