Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) Public Assistance (PA) Program:

Designated Areas and Types of Assistance:

Designated Area: Howard County

Types of Assistance: Public Assistance (Assistance for emergency work and the repair or replacement of disaster-damaged facilities)

The Applicant Briefing is conducted by the State and provides high-level information regarding the Public Assistance Program.

It is encouraged that potential Applicants attend an Applicant Briefing, but it is not required.

Eligible Applicants:

FEMA provides assistance to eligible Applicants, which are listed below:

- A. **State and Territorial Governments**
- B. **Indian Tribal Governments (Federally Recognized)**
- C. **Local Governments**

The following types of local governments are eligible Applicants:

- Counties and parishes
- Municipalities, cities, towns, boroughs, and townships
- Local public authorities
- School districts
- Intrastate districts
- Councils of governments (regardless of whether incorporated as nonprofit corporations under State law)
- Regional and interstate government entities
- Agencies or instrumentalities of local governments
- State-recognized Tribes
- Special Districts established under State law (i.e., Community Development Districts)

- D. **Private Nonprofit Organizations (PNP)**

Private nonprofit organizations that provide an eligible service are categorized as critical and non-critical.

- Critical services include education, utility, emergency or medical.
- Non-critical PNPs provide essential governmental services and are open to the general public. (Refer to the Public Assistance Program and Policy Guide/January 2016)

Requests for Public Assistance (RPA) must be completed and received by the Maryland Emergency Management Agency (MEMA) by October 17, 2016.
